During daylight saving months, thanks largely to Ken helped by John, most of the longer events are run around Yarra Bend Park and the Merri Creek trails. We haven't lost any runners so far but have made a few modifications to ensure the safety of participants by improving the efficiency of the starts and finishes.

Collingwood Venue again successfully conducted the two Victoria Masters annual events it has hosted for the last few years:

- the Cross Country Championship (in Yarra Bend Park) and,
- the 10 kilometre Track Championship.

Some of our Club members competed in these two events and in Vic Masters events at other venues. We were also well represented at various other events locally, interstate and internationally and, in particular, at the Barb Dalgleish Memorial Relay where we just failed to retain the trophy.

Our website is working well and is used for posting the *Programme*, *Results* of the weekly events and *News* of interest and importance to members – there is also information about Victorian, Australian and World *Masters Athletics*.

We continue to enjoy regular social events during the year and always welcome visitors, friends and family members who want to join us.
